Kairaku-en is a Japanese garden located in Mito, Ibaraki. Along with Kenrokuen and Korakuen, it is considered one of the Three Great Gardens of Japan. Kairakuen was built relatively recently in the year 1841 by the local lord Tokugawa Nariaki. Kairakuen is most attractive during the plum blossom season, which usually takes place in late February and March. Besides the plum tree forest, where one hundred different plum tree varieties with white, pink and red blossoms are planted, Kairakuen also features a bamboo grove, cedar woods and the **Kobuntei**, a traditional Japanese style building. - **The Tokugawa Museum 徳川ミュージアム** : 10:00 a.m.-4:00p.m.

Closed on Mondays. When a national holiday falls on a Monday, the Museum is open.

Fee : When 3 exhibition rooms are open--- Adults 1,200yen, Children 900yen.

When 2 exhibition rooms are open--- Adults 1,100yen, Children 800yen

When 1 exhibition room are open--- Adults 800yen, Children 600yen.
