

KINUGAWA HOT SPRINGS 鬼怒川温泉



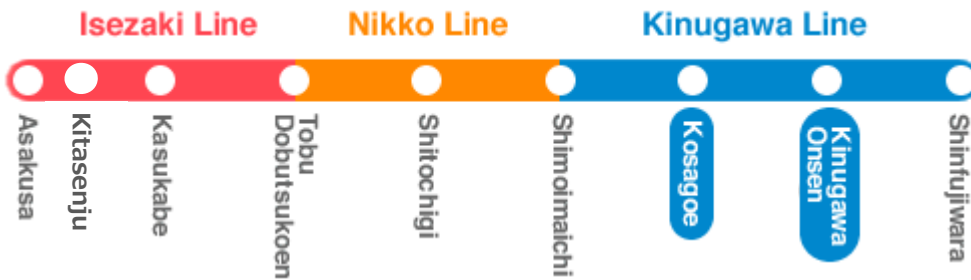
Kinugawa Hot springs together with Hakone and Atami is considered so called Tokyo oku-zashiki or sitting sites away from Tokyo. Hot springs in Kinugawa were discovered in 1752 and since that time visited by highly ranked samurai or daimyo and Buddhist monks. At present the place is visited by approximately 2 million tourists and you can become one of them. When you remember that check in time into your hotel is usually in the evening, you have all day to visit theme parks like Tobu World Square with miniatures of famous buildings from all over the world (World Trade Center still can be seen only here), Western Village with Mt. Rushmore, Edo Wonderland, Monkey Performance Park, river boats and mountain hiking.

By train: 2 hours by express train Tobu from Kitasenju Station

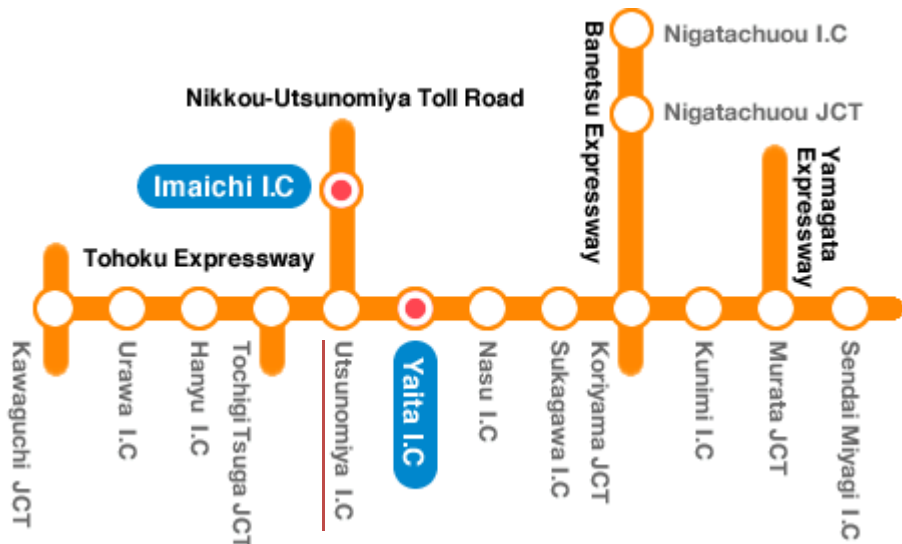

By car : Take Kita-kanto highway from Sakurakawa-chikusei IC to Utsunomiya-kami-mikawa IC, then take Nikko-kaido to Utsunomiya IC, Turn at the Utsunomiya IC of the Tohoku Expressway to the Nikkou-Utsunomiya Toll Road, and leave this Toll Road at the Imaichi Interchange out of Imaichi/Kinugawa-Onsen Exit. Then drive on National Route 121 toward Kinugawa-onsen.

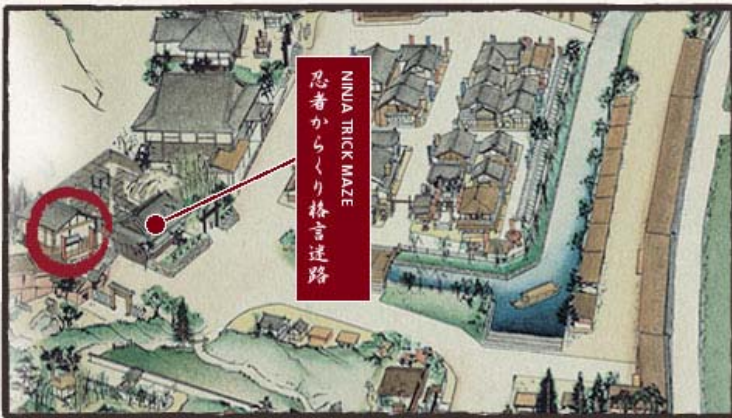
Edo Wonder Land 日光江戸村 :

Open throughout the year, 9:00am through 5:00pm
9:30am-4:00pm during the December 1-March 19
Admission fee: 4,700yen /adults, 2,400yen/ children



The Oiran Parade is an elegant procession of courtesans strolling down the wide avenue. Wearing broad knotted sashes and elaborately devised hairstyles, the oiran courtesans proceed slowly along accompanied by the sound of their wooden geta clogs. The procession is accompanied by young servants and attendants. The Oiran Parade is held on the main street; be sure not to miss it!

Tobu World Square 東部ワールドスクエア:

Open throughout the year, 9:00am - 5:00pm
9:30am-4:00pm during the December 1-March 19
Admission fees: 2,500yen /adults, 1,200yen/ children

By Car:

Turn at the Utsunomiya Interchange of the Tohoku Expressway to the Nikkou-Utsunomiya Toll Road, and leave this Toll Road at the Imaichi Interchange out of Imaichi/Kinugawa-Onsen Exit.

Then drive on National Route 121 toward Kinugawa-onsen for approx. 20 minutes to get to the Park.

By Train:

Approx. 2 hours by Tobu Super Express Train "SPACIA" from Tobu Asakusa Station to Kinugawa-Onsen Station, from which a 5-minute Bus ride to the Park.

If you use an express train (Kaisoku), get off at Kosagoe Station and walk approx. 8 minutes to the Park.



Ashi-yu 足湯:



It is facilities only in warming it with a foot in the hot spring.
There is four Ashi-yu in Kinugawa, one of Ashi-yu is in front of a Kinugawa Onsen Station.
