(5)Garbage collection

(6)Procedure for entering JAEA

Although JAEA main gate will be closed between December 29 and January 3, if necessary, you can enter the J-PARC site through a side door at the main gate of JAEA. In this case, you need to specify the reason of your visit to a guard via an intercom at the door. And then, you must stop by the guard house to show your Photo ID.

(7)Others

Please be aware of all sorts of things as there will not be many people on site during the holidays. Make sure to turn off electric power/gas etc. and make sure doors are locked.
